DIRECTIONS: Whittier Park is in Royal Oak at the corner of Farnum and Potter. If you are at 11 Mile and Main streets in downtown Royal Oak, proceed NORTH on Main $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to Farnum. Turn right at the light and go down $\frac{1}{2}$ mile. Whittier Park is on the right.
