NOTEWORTHY ITEMS

Rules Review, Touching Down Before the Volley by Dennis Dacey, USAPA Rules Chair, from USAPA e-Newsletter us4.campaign-archive1.com/?u=55b122122aa28dd9bfbdbd8222&id=17ef0ae312#mctoc5
Last month we covered rule 9.C. of the Non-Volley Zone (NVZ) rules. We're going to stay with Section 9 of the rules, but this month it is Rule 9.D.

First a question: Is it possible to hit a volley from mid court, or even near the baseline, and have a foot fault in the NVZ? The answer is YES. Are you surprised?

Rule 9.D. states in part "***If a player is inside the NVZ for any reason that player cannot volley the return until both feet are on the playing surface outside the NVZ.***"

So, think about it. I've seen this happen many times. A player will be up near the NVZ. He will inadvertently put a foot in the NVZ when pushing off to back up for a deep volley. If that foot does not make contact with the court outside the NVZ before hitting the volley it is a foot fault. A player is normally a little shocked when called for this fault, but it happens more times than you might think. Referees, be on the lookout for this as well as other foot faults in the NVZ – that's your job.
